More than 50 pc new MF investors from small cities: Report

Mumbai, Oct 4 (IANS) Participation of investors from small cities in the stock market has rapidly increased in recent months as the mutual fund industry has added 2.3 crore investor folios from April till August 2024, out of which more than 50 per cent of them come from such areas, a report said on Friday. "The number of new investor folios coming from smaller cities has been rising on a monthly basis. Such trends can foster a culture of saving and investing, ultimately contributing to long-term industry growth," a Zerodha Fund House report said. The report further said that smaller cities still account for only 19 per cent of the overall assets under management (AUM) of the mutual fund industry. It indicates that while more individuals from these regions are participating in investments, but the average investment size may still be lower compared to those from urban areas. These smaller cities and towns are classified as B-30 cities (beyond the top 30 cities) by the Association of Mutual Funds of India (AMFI). As of August 2024, about 54 per cent of all the SIP accounts in the mutual fund industry are contributed by SIPs from smaller cities. Smaller cities have a larger number of SIP accounts reflecting greater penetration in less urbanised areas. From April to August 2024, the growth rate in the SIP accounts in smaller cities for index funds (18.7 per cent) is higher than the growth rate of any other category in the industry.

Samsung begins mass production of industry-leading SSD for AI computers

Seoul, Oct 4 (IANS) Samsung Electronics said on Friday that it has begun mass production of its latest industry-leading solid-state drive (SSD) product, optimal for usage in powerful artificial intelligence personal computers.

Samsung said the PM9E1 SSD, which boasts the industry's highest performance and largest capacity, is built on its in-house 5-nanometer-based controller and eighth-generation V-NAND technology.

According to the company, the PM9E1 will provide powerful performance and enhanced power efficiency, making it an optimal solution for on-device AI PCs. Key attributes have all been improved compared with its predecessor, reports Yonhap

news agency. Starting with the PM9E1, Samsung plans to expand its advanced SSD offerings to global PC makers and expects to launch consumer products based on the product in the future to solidify its market leadership.

"Our PM9E1 integrated with a 5nm controller delivers industry-leading power efficiency and utmost performance validated by our key partners," said Bae Yong-cheol, Samsung's executive vice president of memory product planning.

Meanwhile, the world's largest memory chip maker has started mass production of the industry's thinnest mobile DRAM, LPDDR5X DRAM, tailored to on-device artificial intelligence. The new 12-nanometer (nm)-class 12-gigabyte (GB) and 16GB LPDDR5X DRAM packages are only 0.65 mm high, making them the thinnest LPDDR DRAM in the industry, according to Samsung. The new chip, stacking four layers of 12nm-DRAM die, is 9 per cent thinner and 21.2 per cent more efficient in heat resistance compared to its predecessor. Samsung said the ultra-slim LPDDR5X DRAM packages can create additional space within mobile devices, enabling high-performance applications and advanced features like on-device AI. Riding on the robust performance of its semiconductor business, Samsung's second quarter (Q2) operating profit surged more than 15 times from a year earlier.

New Delhi, Oct 4 (IANS) Driven by the positive response to its Mumbai and Delhi retail stores, Apple on Friday said it is geared up to launch more exclusive, own-branded stores in the country where the iPhone maker is witnessing a surge in domestic sales as well as export figures.

New Apple retail stores will come in Bengaluru, Pune, Delhi-NCR and Mumbai. However, no timeline has been set so far. According to Deirdre O'Brien, Apple's senior vice president of Retail, the company is thrilled "to build our teams as we plan to open more stores in India, because we are inspired by the creativity and passion of our customers across this country." Our

stores are incredible places to experience the magic of Apple, and it's been wonderful to deepen our connection with our customers in India," said O'Brien.

"We can't wait for them to have even more opportunities to discover and shop for our amazing products and services, and connect with our extraordinary, knowledgeable team members," she said in a statement.

The tech giant is now manufacturing the entire iPhone 16 lineup, including iPhone 16 Pro and iPhone 16 Pro Max, in India, the company informed.

The India-made iPhone 16 Pro and Pro Max will soon be available for local customers and for export to select countries across the world.

Apple currently has its own branded retail store in Saket, Delhi, and Bandra Kurla Complex (BKC) in Mumbai.

The India retail expansion comes as Apple is already locally manufacturing the iPhone 16 and Pro models, and exporting them to other countries. The new Apple flagship retail stores will fuel Apple's growth in the years ahead.

Meanwhile, driven by the production-linked incentive

(PLI) scheme, Apple reached more than \$5 billion in iPhone exports from India in the April-August period this fiscal. According to industry data, this is a growth of over 50 per cent from the same period of first five months in FY24.

Hyundai Motor India may launch \$3 bn IPO on October 14

Mumbai, Oct 4 (IANS) Hyundai Motor India is likely to launch a \$3 billion (about Rs 25,000 crore) Initial Public Offering (IPO) on October 14, according to a report. It would be the largest IPO of India after LIC, which was around Rs 21,000 crore. According to several media reports, Hyundai has given final consent for opening the IPO subscription from October 14 to 16. The report further said that barring any unexpected changes in the market due to the conflict between Iran and Israel in the Middle East, it has been agreed to open the subscription of the IPO on these dates. However, no decision has been made

yet regarding the price band. In Thursday's session, the Indian stock market saw a sharp fall due to Iran's missile attack on Israel. During this period, both the frontline indices Sensex and Nifty had closed down by more than 2 per cent. This was the biggest fall in the stock market so far in the last two months. Till now, no official statement has been given by Hyundai regarding the IPO dates. The country's largest IPO has been approved by the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI). The entire IPO of Hyundai Motor India Limited will be an offer for sale (OFS). In an IPO, the company will sell 14.2 crore shares, which is around 17.5 per cent of the total shareholding. Hyundai India is the second largest car company in the country after Maruti Suzuki. The company's market share is around 15 per cent. After the listing, Hyundai India's market cap could be almost half the valuation of its Seoul-listed promoter company Hyundai Motors at \$47 billion. Nearly one in four Hyundai cars is sold in India now.

Time for UPI to break language, location barriers: GPay's Sharath Bulusu

New Delhi, Oct 4 (IANS) While Unified Payments Interface, commonly referred to as UPI, has been a resounding success worldwide, more work is required to break barriers of language, location, and gender, said Sharath Bulusu, Director, Product Management, Google Pay on Friday.

Speaking to IANS on the sidelines of the company's event in the national capital, Bulusu called for reaching out to a wider user base who don't have access to digital payments.

"UPI became a global success, but there is still a lot more growth to happen. There are still many segments of users who don't have access to digital payments, and digital finance," Bulusu said. "We must do a lot to break down barriers,

whether it is language, background, location or gender. We must think about how to do it responsibly and inclusively using good design. But I think global recognition makes it easier for people to have confidence to join UPI," he added.

Developed by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) in 2016, UPI is an Indian instant payment system that facilitates inter-bank peer-to-peer and person-to-merchant transactions. UPI is active in more than 10 countries, and many are in talks to implement it. Bulusu said that everyone must get equal access to digital technologies or digital platforms and the same quality of services.

"It shouldn't matter that you are a farmer in

some corner of rural India, or you are a salaried employee sitting in a city like Delhi".

Bulusu attributed the success of UPI to "joint efforts of private companies, NPCI as a network, RBI as a regulator, and government backing, alongside innovative private applications".

"This is how the industry can truly make a difference to aid digital inclusion," he noted. Bulusu also stressed the impor-

tance and responsibility of informing people of ways to stay safe online. "This goes back to the history of every new development; we have had to educate users to keep their passwords safe, protect the PIN for their debit cards, and safeguard the PIN for their UPI apps. Similarly, we must educate users at every step because the digital world is changing rapidly. It is unfair to expect users to figure it out on their own.

Sensex trades lower amid weak global cues

Mumbai, Oct 4 (IANS) Indian equity markets were trading in the red on Friday following weak cues from US markets. At 9:47 A.M., the Sensex was down 279 points or 0.34 per cent at 82,216 and Nifty was down 69 points or 0.27 per cent at 25,180. Selling was driven by midcap and smallcap stocks. Nifty midcap 100 index was down 413 points or 0.70 per cent at 58,652 and Nifty smallcap 100 index was down 75 points or 0.40 per cent at 18,876. In the Sensex pack, Bajaj Finance, Asian Paints, Bajaj Finserv, NTPC, Tata Steel, UltraTech Cement, Reliance Industries, L&T, SBI, Bharti Airtel, SBI, Nestle and M&P were the top losers. TCS, IndusInd Bank, HCL Tech, ITC, Infosys, Wipro and Tech Mahindra were the top gainers. Among the sectoral indices, Fin Service, FMCG, metal, realty, energy and infra were major losers. IT, PSU Bank and auto were major gainers. The broader market is in a downward trend. On the National Stock Exchange (NSE), 1,335 shares were in the red and 814 shares were in the green. Mixed trading is taking place in Asian markets. Tokyo, Hong Kong and Seoul are in the green while Jakarta and Bangkok are in the red. US markets closed in the red on Thursday.
