Iran's newly-appointed VP Zarif resigns from post

Tehran, Aug 13 (IANS) Mohammad Javad Zarif has resigned from his new post as Iranian Vice-President for strategic affairs and head of the Centre for Strategic Studies, just 10 days after his appointment.

In a post on social media platform X on Sunday night, he said he was "not satisfied with the result of his work" as head of the steering council for selecting the new Iranian administration's cabinet members, Xinhua news agency reported on Monday.

According to Zarif, out of the 19 Ministers proposed by Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian to the country's parliament for approval on Sunday, three were the top recommendations of his council and its committee, while evaluating the more than 1,000 candidates. He added that six nominees were second or third choices

and one was their fifth choice. He stressed that selected by the members was the Iranian President's right, with the steering council and its committee serving only in a consultative role.

In a follow-up post on X on Monday, Zarif said on Sunday in his message "was not a sign of regret or disappointment with Pezeshkian," but rather an indication that he had doubts about his "usefulness" as Vice-President for strategic affairs.

Zarif stressed that he still had faith in everything he had said about Pezeshkian during the election campaign and urged the Iranian people to continue supporting the new President and his administration in a decree on August 17. Pezeshkian appointed Zarif as Vice-President for strategic affairs and head of the Centre for Strategic Studies.



X-RATED TRUMP

The former US president returned to Twitter/X with an interview with the Tesla billionaire that started 43 minutes late after the social media site's servers were hammered with a Distributed Denial of Service (DDoS) attack. Once up and running, Trump spoke about becoming more religious after the attempt on his life in Pennsylvania on July 13, a shooting that Musk said showed Trump's courage. The 45th President of the United States also vowed to build an 'Iron Dome' defence system for America like the one used by Israel to intercept missiles and promised that he would oversee the largest deportation of illegal immigrants in history if he became president in November.

5.5-magnitude earthquake shakes several Syrian provinces

Damascus, Aug 13 (IANS) A magnitude 5.5 earthquake struck 28 km east of the central city of Hama, according to the Syrian National Earthquake Centre.

The quake, which was felt in several Syrian provinces, occurred at 11:56 p.m. local time on Monday at a depth of 3.9 km east of the city of Hama, Xinhua news agency reported.

This tremor follows an earlier earthquake recorded at 9:30 p.m. on Monday with a magnitude of 3.7.

The earlier quake's epicentre was located 21 km east of Hama.

No immediate reports of casualties or significant damage were released by authorities.

The state TV posted safety measures on its social media outlets, advising residents to remain vigilant as aftershocks could occur.

Head of the Syrian

National Earthquake Centre, Riad Ahmad, was quoted by the pro-government Sham FM radio station as saying that the earthquake hit northern and western Syria in 2023, resulting in significant destruction, 2023, resulting in significant destruction.

Poland signs deal for manufacturing 48 Patriot system launchers

Warsaw, Aug 13 (IANS) Poland has signed a contract to build 48 M903 launchers for the US-designed Patriot air defence systems, said Polish Defence Minister Włodzisław Kosiniak-Kamysz.

According to the deal worth \$1.23 billion, the launchers, set to be built at Stalowa Wola steelworks in Poland, are expected to be delivered to around four per cent of its 2027 and 2029, Xinhua news agency reported on Monday.

On Friday, Poland inked a deal with the US to buy hundreds of AIM-120C AMRAAM air-to-air missiles.

Last month, the Polish Defence Ministry announced that the US would lend Poland \$2 billion to fund the purchase of American air and missile defence systems.

Poland has increased its defence spending to around four per cent of its GDP this year, the highest among NATO countries.

US denies involvement in Bangladesh's political crisis

Washington, Aug 13 (IANS) The US has rejected the allegations of its government's involvement in the Bangladesh crisis, including the protests in the country that led to the deaths of hundreds of people.

Refuting all the reports and rumours, the White House Press Secretary, Karine Jean Pierre, said in a media briefing on Monday (local time) "So, we have had no involvement at all. Any reports or rumours that the United States government was involved in these, in these events is simply, simply false. That is not true."

Jean Pierre also added that Bangladeshis people should determine the future of the Bangladesh government.

"This is a choice for and by the Bangladeshi people. We believe that the Bangladeshi people should determine the future of the Bangladesh government, and that's where we stand. Any allegations, certainly we will continue to say, and what I have said here is simply untrue," she said.

Meanwhile, speaking on the protests outside the White House against the recent attacks on Hindus in Bangladesh, the White House Press Secretary said, "The US is going to continue monitoring the situation."

Jean Pierre said, "We are certainly going to continue monitoring the situation. I don't have anything



else to say or to add beyond that."

"When it comes to any type of human rights issue here, the President has been very consistent in speaking loud and clear in public and also privately and he will continue to do that. But, I don't have any specific engagement to speak to at this time," she added.

Bangladesh is experiencing a fluid political situation, with Sheikh Hasina resigning from the post of Prime Minister on August 5 amid mounting protests.

Musk's Trump interview delayed by cyberattack

Washington, Aug 13 (IANS) The highly anticipated interview of former US President Donald Trump by Elon Musk on the social media platform X that the latter owns was way behind schedule because of technical issues.

There appears to be a massive DDoS attack on X. Musk posted on X 18 minutes after the scheduled start time of 8 p.m. US Eastern Time.

"Working on shutting it down,"

"Worst case," he added, "we will proceed with a smaller number of live listeners and post the con-

versation later."

A distributed denial of service (DDoS) attack, a type of cyberattack in which an attacker overwhelms a website, server, or network resource with malicious traffic, according to one explanation.

Six minutes later, Musk, posted again. "We tested the system with 8 million concurrent listeners earlier today."

Three minutes later, he wrote on X, "We will proceed with the smaller number of concurrent listeners at 8:30 ET and then post the unedited audio immediately thereafter." The

former President was temporarily suspended from X in January 2021, when the social media platform was known as Twitter.

The ban was lifted by Musk after he bought the platform. Trump returned in August 2023 and has posted just one message since. He remains active, however, on Truth Social, the look-alike social media platform that he launched after being banned from X.

Trump returned to X with a flurry of posts and picked up more than 300,000 new followers taking the total to 88.3 mil-

lion followers, which is 80.8 million more than the 7.5 million he had on Truth Social.

X gives Trump a much bigger platform, which according to Musk has 60 million monthly active users (other estimates put it at 540 million).

Truth Social is much smaller - it had only five million monthly active users according to papers it filed during its IPO in March 2024 as reported by Axios. The vast difference in the reaches of X and Truth Social won't be lost on Trump, who pays a lot of attention to the size of

the crowd for his election rallies and events.

Musk is a supporter of Trump and is likely to be a friendly interviewer, but the former President is known to be both a showman and unpredictable, and the interview will be closely followed by allies and the Harris campaign.

The Trump campaign needs a bump. Trump had the upper hand in the 2024 presidential election till President Joe Biden was in the fray. The race has changed since Biden dropped out and endorsed his deputy, Vice-President Kamala Harris.

South Korea's heatwave death toll rises to 21

Seoul, Aug 13 (IANS) South Korea's heatwave death toll has risen to 21 so far this year, with almost 2,300 people treated for heat-related illnesses.

The Ministry of the Interior and Safety said, "A 56-year-old man died during hospital treatment on Monday after being found on the street near his home the previous day, reports Xinhua news agency, quoting the ministry."

The death raised the heat-related death toll to 21 between May 20 and

US mediates with Turkey to bring Hamas for Thursday peace talks

Tel Aviv, Aug 13 (IANS) The US Secretary of State Antony Blinken has spoken to the Turkish Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan to bring the militant group Hamas to the negotiating table.

An indirect peace talks between Israel and Hamas is to be held at Doha, Qatar, on Thursday at the insistence of the US.

Qatar and Egypt will be part of the negotiations along with the US representatives. Sources

in Israel's Defence Ministry told IANS that Blinken made the call early Tuesday morning and informed the Turkish government of the importance of peace talks taking place.

It is to be noted that Turkey has an excellent rapport with the Hamas leadership and many of the senior leaders of the militant movement reside in Turkey.

After the murder of Hamas Political Bureau Head Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran on July 31, the situation in the Middle East has become more tense, with certainty of an attack

on Israel looming large. The US has taken the initiative for an indirect peace talks.

However, Hamas has not responded to the apprehensions in attending the talks and informed the mediators to present a plan based on the previous negotiations instead of entering into a new round of talks. Meanwhile, the US State Department Deputy Spokesperson, Vedant Patel told media persons on Monday that he fully expects the talks to continue and was expecting a probable solution to the matter.



Scotland has marked the start of the first grouse shooting season under new legislation requiring a licence for shooting the game birds. The Scottish Government passed the new legislation in March and it is now in full effect as Monday marks the Glorious Twelfth, the official start of grouse shooting season. The Scottish Green Party called for authorities to be vigilant in enforcing the new law and criticised the 'organised cruelty' of grouse shoots. Moors that are home to grouse must now apply for a licence that lasts five years, with NatureScot opening for applications in mid-July.

Congo's former PM elected as Senate President

Kinshasa, Aug 13 (IANS) Jean-Michel Sama Lukonde Kibenge, former Prime Minister of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), was elected President of the Senate.

The former Congo head of government, who took office in February 2021 and resigned in February 2024, was elected President of the DRC parliament's upper house with 84 votes out of 95 during a ballot to elect the members of a permanent bureau, reports Xinhua news agency.

Sama Lukonde, a can-

didate of the Sacred Union, a coalition of political parties around DRC President Felix Tshisekedi, promised his fellow senators earlier in the day to build an "efficient, modern and accessible" Senate.

Sama Lukonde thus succeeded Modeste Bashi Lukweso as on Monday, also a candidate of the Sacred Union, who was elected second Vice President.

Jose Kalala Wa Kalala, a candidate designated by the Sacred Union, was elected first Vice President.

Latvia's airBaltic suspends flights to Tel Aviv over security concerns

Riga, Aug 13 (IANS) The Latvian airline airBaltic has suspended flights to and from Tel Aviv over security concerns, the media reported.

AirBaltic spokesman Augusts Zilberts told the LETA news agency that the security concerns are related to a possible escalation of the conflict in the Middle East. Earlier, airBaltic had cancelled flights to and from Tel Aviv until August 11. Xinhua news agency reported. Zilberts has said that the security situation in Israel was volatile, so the airline remained flexible and was ready to reschedule flights if necessary.

Scorching heatwave to hit half of Romania over next 3 days

Bucharest, Aug 13 (IANS) Romania's National Weather Administration (ANM) has issued code yellow and orange heat warnings for much of the country from August 12 to 14.

The heatwave is expected to bring extreme temperatures and thermal discomfort, with highs ranging between 35 and 39 degrees Celsius, Xinhua news agency reported. On Monday, a code yellow alert is in effect for southern Crisana, Banat, Oltenia, and most of Muntenia, including the capital, Bucharest, where temperatures are expected to reach up to 38 degrees Celsius.

12 civilians killed, 121 injured after Ukraine's attack on Russia's Kursk

Moscow, Aug 13 (IANS) Twelve civilians have died and another 121 have been injured following Ukraine's attack on the Kursk region, Acting governor of the region Alexei Smirnov said.

About 180,000 people are subject to evacuation from the region, and about 120,000 residents have already left, Smirnov said on Monday. Vladimir Putin as reported by Xinhua news agency, Smirnov said 28 settlements are under Ukraine's control, adding that the authorities had no information regarding the 2,000 residents living in those settlements.

85 killed in water-related accidents in Mongolia this year

Ulan Bator, Aug 13 (IANS) A total of 85 people have been killed in water-related accidents across Mongolia since the beginning of this year, according to the country's National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA).

Among the deceased people, 71 were adults and 14 were children, the NEMA said on Monday. The agency attributed the accidents to negligence, leaving children unsupervised, and swimming after consuming alcohol, Xinhua news agency reported.

Russia repelled 7 Ukrainian attacks in Kursk

Moscow, Aug 13 (IANS) Russian military repelled seven Ukrainian attacks in three settlements and thwarted an attempt to penetrate deeper into Russian territory, the Russian Defence Ministry said. The ministry said on Monday in a statement that the attacks were repelled in the settlements of Martynovka, Boriki and Kotenevo over Sunday, Xinhua news agency reported.



Two Israeli audience members were booted and told 'you're not welcome' by stand-up comedian Reginald D Hunter at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe. The US-born entertainer was half-way through the packer-wig at the Edinburgh Festival on Sunday night - described by one theatre critic as the 'ugliest Edinburgh Fringe moment ever' - when the commotion began. Anti-semitism campaigners tonight called the incident 'a sickening low that cannot be disguised as comedy'.
